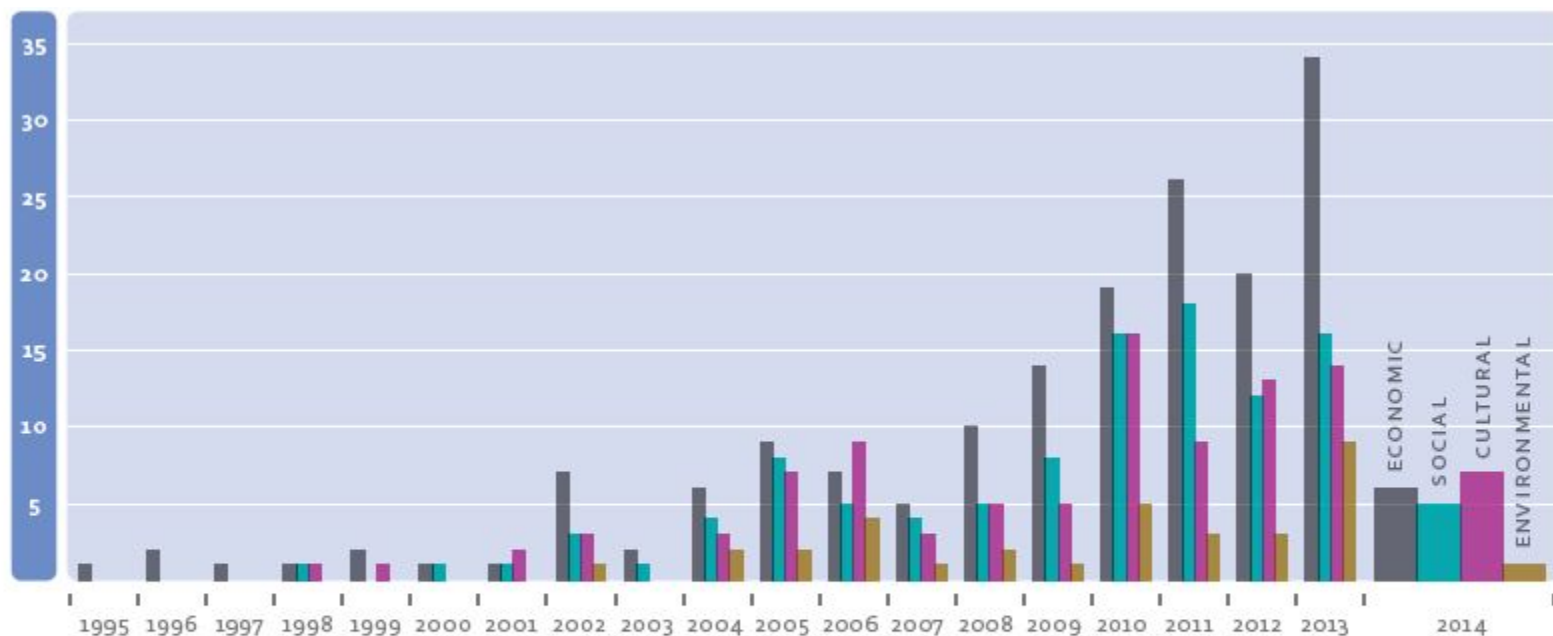


FIGURE 3.2. CHRONOLOGICAL EVOLUTION OF THE IMPACT DOMAINS AS REPRESENTED BY THE SUBMITTED STUDIES

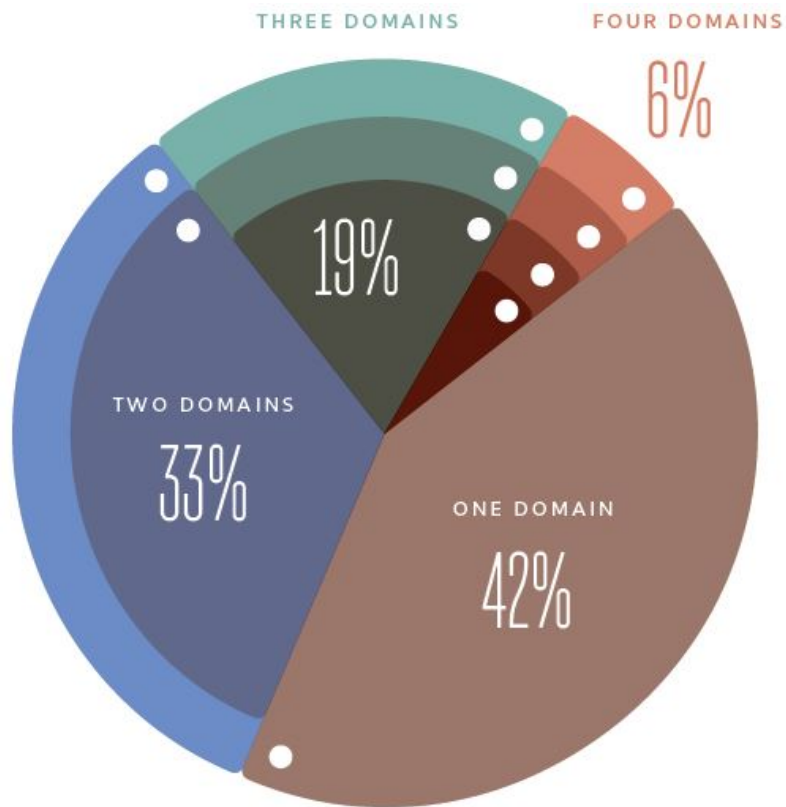


FIGURE 3.4. THE INTERRELATION OF ALL FOUR IMPACT DOMAINS AS IDENTIFIED IN THE COLLECTED STUDIES

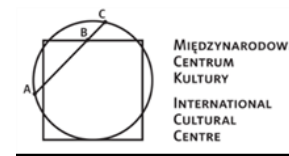

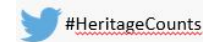


● **Figure 3.7. The different subdomains identified in the collected studies mapped in the holistic four domain approach diagram**
